What are Volunteers in Mission?

Volunteers in Mission share their time, talents, and money for a specific project. The experience is one of sharing with others and serving God by serving others.

Daily morning and evening devotions are held. The volunteers do more than think, read and contribute money to missions. They live, feel, and "DO". Christ challenges us to be followers of His way!

Open Participation

Volunteers in Mission are affiliated with the United Methodist Church. People of all faiths are invited and encouraged to participate. Note: All VIM work camps are tobacco, drug, and alcohol free. Campers are expected to stay at the designated housing and to be flexible, cooperative, and cheerful as we serve God by serving others. All in-state camps assume you will provide your own transportation to and from the project site. Out-of-state camps assume you will use the transportation provided by the work camp leader unless other arrangements are made in advance. All bus trips require that we have 35 people on the bus before others are allowed to drive to the site.

Scholarships

In order to encourage participation, a limited number of scholarships are available and provided through the VIM Endowment Fund with the United Methodist Foundation, Inc. The scholarship request should be made to the trip registrar and returned to the trip registrar.

Work Camp Costs

The basic cost includes a \$75 donation towards materials used as well as administration. Food is supplied on work days as part of the basic cost. Registration is open until one month before the camp; a \$25 deposit will reserve your spot with the balance due two weeks before the camp starts. Deposit for bus trips is always \$50. **VIM 25th ANNIVERSARY REUNION,
Weekend of Saturday May 21st - Sunday May 22nd**

Wisconsin VIM has reached a milestone. February, 2011 to February 2012 will be our 25th year of service. We will commemorate this milestone by holding a reunion for all VIMers who have been part of a work team/s at any time during those 25 years. The reunion will be held at Pine Lake UMC camp near Westfield WI on the weekend of May 21st & 22nd, 2011. This is the weekend following our VIM work week at Pine Lake. Please pass the word to those you know who are no longer active VIMers and may not be receiving this information.

Those attending may arrive at any time on Saturday morning. There will be a noon meal with VIM providing barbeque sandwiches, scalloped potatoes, coffee and lemonade. Those attending are asked to bring potluck items of salads or desserts if you live close enough for this to be convenient for you. An afternoon program of celebration will follow the meal.

You may register to attend on Saturday only, or register to stay overnight in the Retreat Center on Friday night before the event, or Saturday night to extend the fellowship into Sunday. Meal service will be available at camp for those staying over into Sunday **if a minimum of 15 requests are received**. Those who register for this service will be kept advised if the minimum number of requests is not received. There are also restaurants available in Westfield.

Registration cost will be \$5.00 to cover the rental cost of the main lodge and food provided by VIM. Room cost at the Retreat Center is \$59.00 per night (no linens, double occupancy). Each room has a queen and twin bed. An extra person in room charge of \$12.50 per night applies. The meal costs at camp, for those staying over into Sunday, are \$12.00 for supper and \$7.00 for breakfast.

Anyone using a chain saw as a volunteer for VIM must have certified training.

This Chain Saw Training Course is for beginners and experienced cutters with emphasis on safety and working with basic hazards evaluation. This course is limited to 10-15 people.

This course covers:

1. Personal protective equipment
2. Equipment inspection / safe handling of equipment
3. Chain sharpening
4. Basic hazard evaluation / storm damage
5. Tree felling evaluation
6. Working with trees and branches under spring pressure

Nathan Stanford is an Independent Chain Saw Safety Trainer who is highly qualified. Please bring helmet, ear and eye protection. Also bring work boots, gloves, chaps and chain saw if you have them. Dress for the weather. Lunch will be provided. You will receive a wallet card for participating or attending a basic chain saw safety course.
