



## Opportunities for Missions in Honduras in January 2012

This is a wonderful opportunity to get to know the warm people of Honduras and help build their growing churches. Three weeks of missions opportunities are planned in Danli, Honduras. Anyone over age 18 is welcome and you need not speak Spanish to participate in one or more of these weeks. Missioners will stay in the town of Danli for each of the weeks. Each week will be

five days of mission work and one day of sight-seeing in Tegucigalpa, the capital of Honduras. The cost of the trip is approximately \$1500. We are especially seeking doctors, nurses and optometrists.

January 8 - 15, 2012 – This mission provides a free medical and optometric clinic with sewing classes and vacation bible school in Danli.

January 15 - 22, 2012 – This is a medical and optometric and stove construction mission with sewing classes and vacation Bible school in Escuapa. For the stove mission will work in teams of 4 to construct and install cooking stoves in Honduran homes. Stove teams require ability to lift 25-50 pounds.

January 22 - 29, 2012 - This is a stove construction mission with sewing classes and vacation Bible school in La Jagua. For the stove mission will work in teams of 4 to construct and install cooking stoves in Honduran homes. Stove teams require ability to lift 25-50 pounds.

These trips are planned by a partnership of churches in the Wisconsin conference and the Honduran Mission.
